

J.J. College Wins Overall Championship in Women's Boxing

PUDUKKOTTAI, September 11, 2026: The Inter-Collegiate Women's Boxing Championship conducted under the Bharathidasan University was held at J.J. College of Arts and Science, Pudukkottai, on September 10, 2026.

More than **60 students** representing over **17 colleges** from various districts under the jurisdiction of Bharathidasan University participated in the championship. The winners of the individual weight categories will represent the Bharathidasan University team at the All India Inter-University Boxing Championship.

In the **54–57 kg** category, S. Mahalakshmi of J.J. College of Arts and Science, Pudukkottai, secured the first place.

In the **57–60 kg** category, P. Akalya Devi of Sudharsan College won the first place.

In the **60–65 kg** category, S. Divyadarshini of Aadhavan College, Tiruchirappalli, secured the first place.

In the **65–70 kg** category, R. Sajitha of Holy Cross College, Tiruchirappalli, emerged the winner.

In the **70–75 kg** category, V. Renuka of Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, secured the first place.

In the **75–80 kg** category, M. Deepika of Thanthai Periyar Government College, Tiruchirappalli, won the first place.

In the **80+ kg** category, S. Rajeshwari of J.J. College of Arts and Science, Pudukkottai, secured the first place.

Based on the overall performance in the ten weight categories, **J.J. College of Arts and Science, Pudukkottai, won the Overall Championship**. Sudharsan College, Pudukkottai, secured the second place, while Aadhavan College, Tiruchirappalli, secured the third place. Holy Cross College, Tiruchirappalli, secured the fourth place.
